### Summary of Services & Activities

Childminders drop in group. Mondays 9.30am - 11.30am - Open to all who are involved in looking after other peoples children, whether you are a registered childminder, family member or a friend looking after a young child.

New Parent Group. Tuesdays 1.15pm - 2.45pm - Come with your babies up to six months old to meet other parents for friendly and interesting activities including baby massage, talks on weaning, teeth care and treasure baskets

Stay and Play. Thursdays 9.30am - 11.30am - Anyone with children under school age is welcome. Parents/Carers stay with their children and are responsible for their supervision.

Baby Group. Fridays 1.15pm - 2.35pm - For babies six to twelve months old. Activities include messy play, books for babies and music time.
